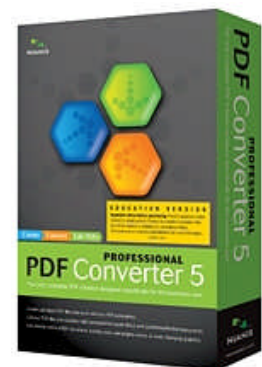

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who is eligible to purchase Student License Products?

Any current student, faculty/teacher, and staff member of a recognized K-12 or Higher Education institution in the U.S or Canada can purchase the software for individual use. For more information, go to www.nuance.com/educationvalidation

2. How will academic status be validated?

Product registration and eligibility validation will be post-sale through Identi-E. www.identi-e.com/nuance

3. Are there any restrictions on student, faculty, and staff purchases?

Yes. Students, faculty and staff may only purchase one (1) copy of a particular product within a 12-month period. Products may only be purchased for personal use (they may not be installed on school/institution owned computers. Products may not be resold or distributed.

HOW IT WORKS

1. Students, faculty or staff purchase "Student License" version. This version is a retail mini-box with a "Student License" sticker and includes electronic documentation and validation instructions, but no serial number to activate the product.
2. To obtain serial number, purchasers must register the product and prove academic status via an online form---www.identi-e.com/nuance
3. Proof of academic status is one of the following:
 - A valid email address that is associated with an academic institution.
 - A school photo identification card that includes date validating current status
 - A school photo ID, Drivers License or other official photo identification with other corroborating evidence including but not limited to: faculty or staff pay check stubs; student course curriculums or tuition bill with a valid date and printed with school's logo or seal; an official letter from the registrar of the school
- For K-12 students only: when the above listed forms of ID are not available, an official letter from a teacher at the accredited K-12 institution verifying the student's right to order software at academic prices.
4. Once validated, serial number is emailed to the student.
